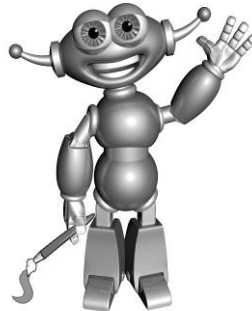


Instructors

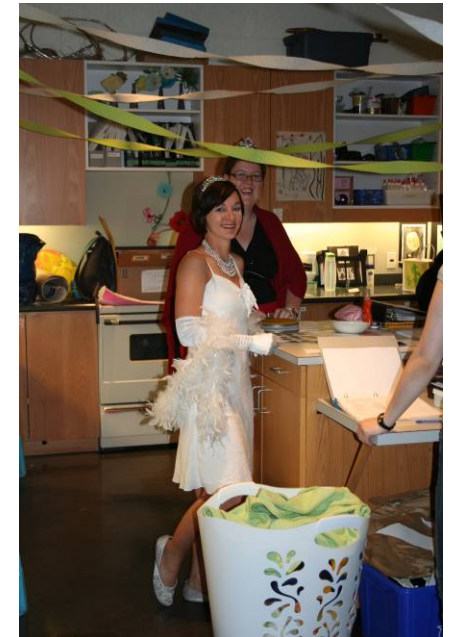
